### Community Reinforcement Approach

(CRA), is a type of behavioral intervention

that utilizes the tools available to the client within their family and community, helping them identify behaviors that are more rewarding than the using behavior.

It recognizes the powerful role of the environment and its contingencies in encouraging or discouraging the addictive behavior, making non-use more valuable and rewarding.
