## Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders

### Informed Approaches for Interprofessional Health Teams

**Fetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorders (FASD)** is an organic, permanent, **brain-based** disability resulting from prenatal alcohol exposure. FASD often goes undiagnosed and can have **lifelong implications**: Substance misuse, mental health problems, and involvement with law enforcement are secondary disabilities that may occur later in life.

**Participants will learn behaviors of FASD over the lifespan and come away with tools to provide informed care and services in a non-biased manner.**

**Target audience includes:** behavioral health professionals, physicians, physician assistants, nurse practitioners, nurses, and others working in healthcare and human services.
