**Objectives:**

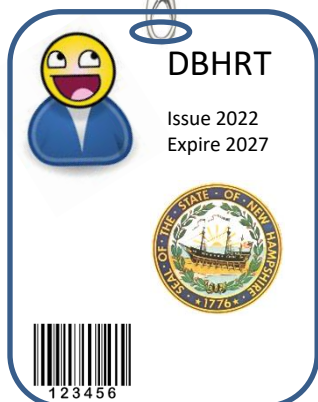
1. To provide the knowledge and skills necessary to assist individuals, families, and communities following critical incidents or disasters.
