Each year, over 650 NH children are poisoned by lead and experience blood lead levels known to impair health and cognitive functions that can be permanent.

For Physicians, APRNs, PAs, RNs, LPNs, MAs, this session will review regional lead exposure/testing data, legislation impacting pediatric providers, and NH's low pediatric blood lead testing rates.
